As this is Deanna's last year with CAS, we would like to recognize her contributions to our organization and her dedication to facilitating Arts & Culture in our community. A thankless position that often carries more stress than it does rewards, Deanna is a tireless volunteer and advocate for the arts. Under her guidance and direction the Creative Airdrie Society has become the hub for investment, promotion, engagement, development and education of the arts in Airdrie.

She recently chaired the committee for ARTember, an annual free family arts & culture festival. This event garnered our city the prestigous honour of being named 1 of the 5 designated Arts & Culture sites in all of Alberta by the provincial government. The festival is massive in scale and requires thousands of dollars and hundreds of volunteer hours to put on. This money is raised through grants, sponsorships and many fundraising efforts. It is by no means an easy task and Deanna has managed to handle it with both grace and innovation in a difficult economic environment.

In the future we can look forward to her spearheading the Canada 150 Mosaic project which she brought to the board and will be a legacy art installation for our city.
